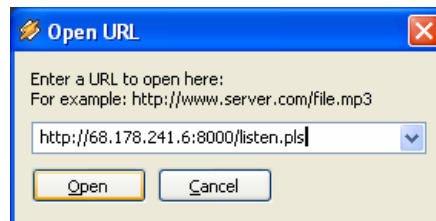

How To Listen Using WinAmp:

Go to the WinAmp website at <http://www.winamp.com> and download the latest free version of Winamp player. Open and save it to your computer's "Program Files" folder. Once you have installed it, all you'll need to do is simply click on the red "Listen" button on the left side of our website's front page.

Should you have difficulty playing, simply open WinAmp and click the little 'sine wave' icon on the top left corner of WinAmp. Choose "Play" and then choose "URL". A box will pop up (see below) asking you for the URL.



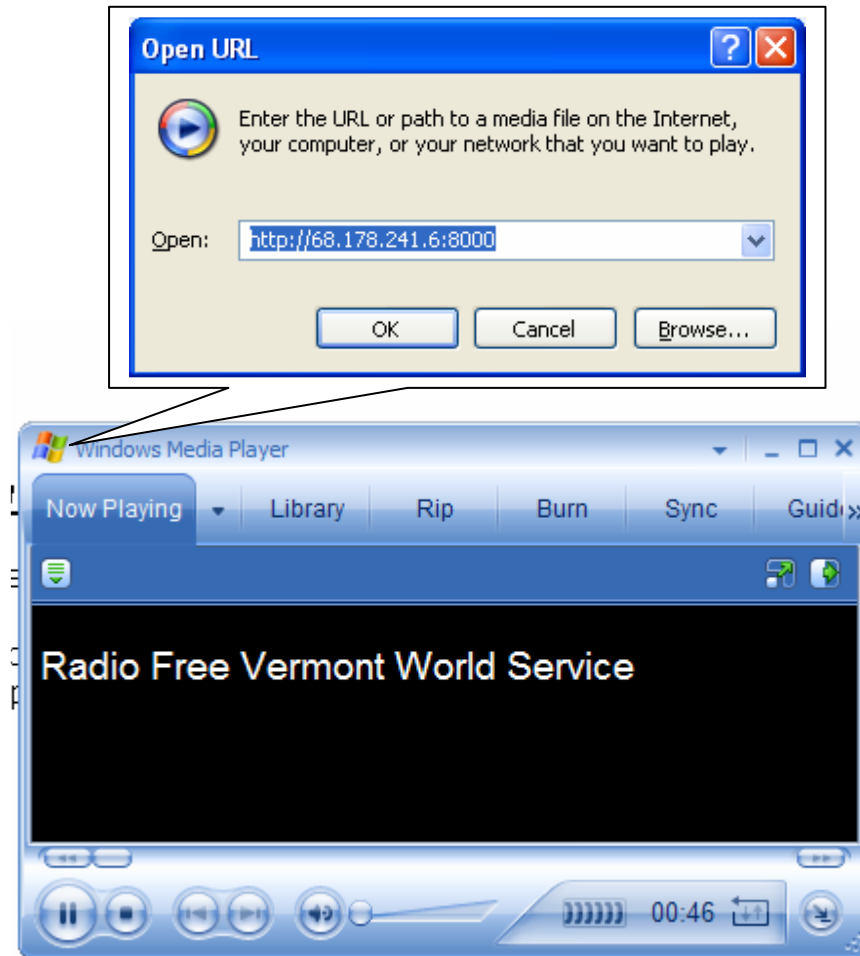
Type in this address: <http://68.178.241.6:8000/listen.pls> and then click Open. Wait a few seconds for the stream to load. Turn it up and enjoy!



How To Listen Using Windows Media Player:

Start, All Programs, Accessories, Entertainment, Windows Media Player.

Right click on the top left corner of Windows Media Player at the Windows logo. Choose File, the choose Open URL and type in <http://68.178.241.6:8000>. Note: Unlike WinAmp, you don't type in the 'listen.pls' part of the address as Windows Media Player doesn't like it and will give you an error message. Click OK. Turn up the volume and enjoy!



There are other players on the market, but these are the most used and easiest for most people. For most other players, the instructions are basically the same using a File / Open or Location/Open URL dialog.

For Linux, we recommend you use Xmms. For Apple, use iTunes.
